A part of that job was to conduct focus groups in our Spanish speaking community. Our fantastic parent/staff reached out to hundreds of program participants and conducted the largest number of focus groups with the largest number of Latino/a/x parents in the district. The advocacy of SKCE Latino/a/x staff and
